

## **HELP! A BEATLES TRIBUTE, HIGHLY RECOMMENDED**

I was there as a representative of the (Dutch) Beatles fan club. The performance took place in “Het Hof van Salland” in Diepenveen, Overijssel, which for the occasion had been transformed into a cozy concert hall.

It was the first time that the band performed in Holland, and I’m happy to announce that this cover band will do more shows in Holland in October.

With their energetic performance the band proved they are the best Beatles cover band.

The members of the band are modest enough to admit that other bands probably look better, as for example they have a left-handed bass guitarist to play Paul McCartney’s part.

But when it comes down to the vocals, the music, and its experience on stage and in the concert hall *Help!* shows they are the perfect act.

Besides, it is refreshing to hear all the famous Beatles songs being played live; this goes for the classic rock and roll music, as well as for the songs that have never been performed live by the Beatles, like “Yellow Submarine.”

It is characteristic for the quality of the Beatles and of *Help!* that the audience consisted of people from the surroundings of Diepenveen who were not even really big fans of the Beatles, but who just wanted to have a good time. From the first song on *Help!* lived up to the expectations.

And so, Beatles lovers are advised to visit a concert next October when *Help!* will play in Holland again.
